14. Need to hire someone to do work at north end of 32<sup>nd</sup>, keeps washing out; work done last fall is all washed away. Need to do grass, cement work, landscaping etc at city building.
15. Discussion held about work being done to east of Frontier. One residential lot has been sold already. Possibly a Burger King to be built just east of the curves east side of Frontier.
