FRONTIER JUNE 2016 COUNCIL MEETING

Present: BJ Blanchette, Wade Borth, Gayle Anderson, Jessica Metcalf, Jonathan Garaas, Joann

Brandenburg. Blanchette presiding over meeting, in absence of Neil Krueger.

1. Motion to approve May minutes - Wade Borth Second – Gayle Anderson, In favor – Borth, Anderson, Metcalf.
2. Waste Management/Recycling: complaints from some residents about the recycling, had WM pick up containers, called WM and told they wouldn't be charged. Resident felt there should have been a vote. Council has discussed this a number of times, garbage is an essential service. WM bills residents, not the city. Signed a 5 year contract with WM, for garbage pickup and recycling.
3. Election – Gayle and BJ terms expire by next meeting. Jon Whiting and Adam Sibernagel are running for the two 4 year positions. Vote is June 14. Residents request a 'Meet and Greet' before next election, so they can meet the candidates. Whiting was present, and residents had a couple of questions for him. Residents want detailed account of votes, including list of write- ins.
4. Neil Krueger has moved, resigned as of this meeting date June 13. 2 years are left of his position. Council may appoint mayor for remaining 2 years, unless 2 residents (5% of last election voters), in writing, request a special election. This must be done within 15 days of resignation, turned in to auditor. ND Century Code section 40-08-16.
5. Landscaping – have not started yet. Resident had concerns about flagpole – cost, caring of flag, etc.
6. Perry Ronning – has been doing some research about assessor buildings, if put into flood plain area, some lenders want to include all property in flood plain.
7. Earlise Duciaume had question about remodeling deck – no permit is required for deck.
8. 2 fireworks permits have been issued. ** Residents, please be respectful of your neighbors when you are shooting fireworks – consider lateness of display, etc.
9. Mowing – Wayne Wagner has agreed to mow the areas in Frontier. Had questions about the boundaries of city lot – will look at after meeting. Presented bill for 4 mowings.
10. Wade will contact Jay Titus about possibly installing garage door opener.
11. Question about golf carts, 4 wheelers, etc. that are running stop signs – don't they have to follow speed limits, stop signs? They should, if there are problems, contact Cass County Sheriff Dept.
12. Question about swing set/playground equipment for city lot – this is not included in the landscape project. Will be something that will be addressed at a later time.
13. Mosquito spraying – has not been needed to this point this summer. Residents would like more, or better, notice about when spraying would take place. It is usually in the Forum, on local television, and radio. Airborne Spraying does the notices for this.
14. Other concerns from residents:
 - a. Want meeting minutes sent out sooner, and more detailed.

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- b. Include financial statement each month
- c. Wondering how much is left on specials? ***if anyone wants to know amount/time left on specials, please contact Joann.
- d. Make check deposits on a more regular basis.
