TAX EQUALIZATION MEETING

Bob Staloch, Assessor: there will be a 4% across the board raise in values to the homes in Frontier. Previous year the county required an 8% raise. Discussion held. Motion to accept the assessor's report, with a 4% increase – Wade Borth Second – Jon Whiting In favor – Borth, Whiting, Sibernagel, Metcalf.

1. Motion to approve March 2018 minutes – Jon Whiting Second – Adam Silbernagel

2. June Election – Petitions were turned in, Mayor – BJ Blanchette For two council positions – Terry Chambers, Wade Borth

5. Home rule Charter – Sales Tax – Wade Borth: Home rule would have to be done, cost of \$10,000 to \$30,000 – one time charge. Would need a vote by residents to pass it. Lots of leg work, is it worth it? Discussion held, table it for now.
6. Vector Control – Cass County – Motion to accept and sign contract for mosquito control – Wade Borth Second – Jessica Metcalf In favor – Borth, Metcalf, Whiting, Silbernagel
7. CLEANUP DAY will be MAY 18. Contact Waste Management if there is a question about what will be accepted.
8. Two stops signs are down, 36th St., and 32nd St. BJ will check with Wade Olsen as to who did our repairs before.
9. Community BBQ – get to know residents, do it during National Night Out week – August 7. Will do planning for it.
10. Cracks in streets are opening up. Wade checked with Tri State – same price as other years – Motion to have cracks filled in as soon as possible – Adam Silbernagel

11. Garaas presented the completed ordinances, will do a more completed table of contents.

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12. Cost of snow removal is keeping in line with budget.
13. Question about cd's, these are set for automatic renewal, should set up as nonrenewal, may get a better rate at other banks.
