

FRONTIER COUNCIL MEETING

1. Motion to approve June 2014 minutes – Gayle Anderson Second – BJ Blanchette In favor – Anderson, Blanchette, Borth
2. No news on Oye property
3. Pumping of storm sewer drain by business west of city lot-discussion held. Tri-State paving gave estimate for repair of 4 areas, council felt price was too high, BJ will try and get other bids. Meeting with Asplin about cleaning ditches, etc has been repeatedly postponed. Neil contacted Cutting Edge GroundsCare-Josh Abrahamson. Gave estimate for mowing, removing brush, etc, dirt around city building, seed grass, mowing along 52nd, and dirt work, seeding along 52nd. Motion to hire Cutting Edge, for up to \$4000, for ditch work, dirt, seeding, etc (above work) - BJ Blanchette Second – Gayle Anderson In favor – Blanchette, Anderson, Borth.
4. Culvert on 56th –City of Fargo: needs to be replaced or removed. Will meet with Jason Leonard about this project. Removal or replacement would be at Frontier's cost. Discussion held.
5. Lift station by Finley's went down, during heavy rain last month, frontage ditch by Finley's filled with water.
6. Neil purchased flare ends for culvert on 32nd, asked for reimbursement. Motion to reimburse – BJ Blanchette Second –Wade Borth In favor – Blanchette, Borth, Anderson
7. Mosquito aerial spraying has been done several times. Discussion held.
8. Maybe do another BBQ/picnic sometime in September. Discuss next month.
9. Cleanup day – need to have a date set, after landscaping has been completed.
10. Fireworks – 5 registered complaints, before the 4th of July. Officials were called, but found no problems. Fireworks being shot off very late, was probably coming from Silver Leaf to the east of Frontier. Discussion held. City receives \$10,000 in permit fees for fireworks stands. Most residents seem to enjoy the fireworks for the short time they are allowed.
11. Question as to when Germanson will be starting work on his project? Have Perry check on this.
12. First rental of the center went well.
13. Cass County Electric has not started any project yet.

1. Some residents have complaints about low water pressure. Wade will call Rural water about this.
