

FRONTIER OCTOBER COUNCIL MEETING

- 1. Motion to approve September 2014 minutes BJ Blanchette Second Wade Borth In favor Blanchette, Borth, Anderson, Metcalf
- 2. Reponses about opening up cul-de-sac on 35th and road west of city building 2 residents were against it, also council does not see a reason to open it up at this time. Ordinance was passed to make that area a park; west of that is a street. Need to once again look into the drainage problem there, maybe next spring. Take pictures of problem areas, talk to engineer.
- 3. Culvert on east end of 56th has been removed, work needs to be finished. Also they (CuttingEdge Landscaping) will make pad for shed by city building.
- 4. Neil will put markers by culverts, for spring runoff.
- 5. Community party-Wade Borth: discussion held as to if and when another one should be held. Nice to get together and meet other residents. Will discuss again next month.
- 6. Fireworks right now shooting of fireworks goes with state law. Problem with someone shooting fireworks in mid-September, between 12 am and 2 am. If this happens again, locate who is doing it, and contact Cass County Sheriff.
- 7. Renting of center by a nonprofit- would still have to pay the \$25 fee, discussion held.
- 8. Email directory to Jessica and BJ.
- 9. Insurance ratings good for Horace Fire Department. Frontier does not have fire hydrants, so that affects our ratings.
- 10. Snow removal bids from FM Snow Removal current, Smithco, and Staloch. FM has done a great job in the past. Discussion held.
- 11. Excel price is very high to install lines right now, very busy. Discussion held.
- 12. Stop lights are in on 52nd and frontage, but are temporary according to City of Fargo. They will be doing a traffic study this winter. Council agrees that stop lights are definitely needed. Discussion held about changing stop sign, connecting frontage and 31st St. to a yield sign. Probably not ours to change.
- 13. 2015 budget is done, maybe start next years in May or June.
- 14. Nothing more on the Oye court date.



- 15. Fema flood insurance letter rec'd. Perry Ronning is in charge of this, will discuss the basement exemptions, etc. Discuss with Perry next month.
- 16. There is a fox roaming around Frontier, has been seen in a few locations, keep an eye out for this.
- 17. Burning of leaves, etc. within the city complaint from a resident about smoke, etc. At one time council discussed putting a dumpster for yard waste, but was very expensive. Council's suggestion: Be curious to your neighbors, let them know if you are planning to burn; don't burn on windy days, etc.
- 18. Question had been asked about someone wanting to purchase a house and turn it into a commercial daycare. They would not be living in the house. This would not be allowed.
- 19. Property to the east special meeting was held by the City of Fargo. A lot of work is being done this fall, more next spring. Frontier's biggest concern is drainage from the city, and back yards along the east side.
