

FRONTIER NOVEMBER COUNCIL MEETING

1. Motion to approve October 2014 minutes – BJ Blanchette, Second – Wade Borth
In favor – Blanchette, Borth, Anderson
2. Memory Fireworks/Sky Digital Advertising: Application for a new sign by Memory Fireworks, has been approved by state already. Discussion held. Ordinance needs changing, & have two readings, tonight being one. Ordinance will be ready for next meeting.
3. Neil gave permission for Frank Palm to replace fence at cul-de-sac. Was taken down during ditch maintenance.
4. Culvert – end of 56th – still isn't completely finished with work, shed was moved this past month. Bill presented from Cutting Edge Lawn Care for \$2425, for mowing, culvert removal and ditch work. Motion to pay – BJ Blanchette, Second – Gayle Anderson

5. Neil installed markers by culverts for spring drainage in residential area.
6. Community Party – wait until spring.
7. Fireworks being shot off late at night, apology from resident. Recently fireworks were shot off early evening. Discussion held.

9. Snow removal – will continue with current provider – FM Snow Removal, will keep other bids for future.
10. Oye court date – date set, but attorneys were not notified. Will be set again for next month.
11. Perry – city doesn't qualify for basement exemptions, need update of ordinance. First reading of Model C ordinance, Second reading in December – Motion to approve 1st model C reading – Wade Borth Second – BJ Blanchette In favor – Borth, Blanchette, Anderson.
12. Property to east – road is shaped, a lot of work done this fall. Question about drainage behind Borth and Titus – Neil will contact.

13. Renting of Community Center – Chris & Joyce Hesse are the committee right now. Council appoints Jessica Metcalf to be on this committee also, from the council. Someone looking at July 25 for rental.
14. Perry: Germanson property is about done, looks good. No permit was gotten for screened addition on 33rd St.-Perry will address this. Oyes – have never had a final inspection, Perry will contact. Garaas will contact Greg Lang about prior permits, paper work.
15. Question had been asked about current fuel charge on garbage bill – this has been on bills for a few years. Neil spoke to provider about recycling: will not offer curbside, but would do a dropoff site (probably at center), would cost \$1 per household per month. **Is there interest in this from majority of residents? Let a council person know.**
16. Randy Finley requested – if city gets bids on culvert repair, let him know, would be interested in repairing his. ** Clean leaves, etc from around culverts, for spring drainage.
