2. Discussion about attorney/home rule charter. List of what needs to be done for charter. *****Council is considering : initiate a home rule charter (motion), appoint a charter commission of at least 5 members. Ian McLean, attorney, will be present at October’s meeting for any questions about this matter.**
3. Chambers got a new flag and cord, will take care of this from now on.
4. Mosquito spraying was done 2 times, and also coordinated with city of Fargo’s spraying.
5. Septic Tanks are still being pumped.

9. Cleaning of center’s chairs and maybe scotch guard – Joann will take care of. Motion to have chairs cleaned, not to exceed \$500 – Jon Whiting Second – Terry Chambers In favor – Whiting, Chambers, Silbernagel, Borth
10. *****Clean out ends of culverts on all residents’ driveways, to help with spring drainage.** Mow culvert/ditch along frontage road – Dabbert will take care of this. Motion to have Dabbert mow ditch, not to exceed \$250 – Wade Borth Second – Adam Silbernagel In favor – Borth, Silbernagel, Chambers, Whiting

12. 2021 Budget – discussion held. Changes made. Motion to accept 2021 budget as written – Jon Whiting, Second – Terry Chambers In favor – Whiting, Chambers, Silbernagel, Borth
